SUMMER FOOTBALL 2022/23 PLAYER REGISTRATION FEES

Please find listed below the Player Registration fees for the 2022/23 Summer Football Season.

Summer Football Registration Fees (GST Inclusive)	
Categories	Total
Junior	\$6
Senior	\$22

- Summer Football competitions can be conducted between 1st September 2022 and 31st March 2023.
- Senior players are those turning 19 and above in 2022
- Youth players are those turning up to 18 in 2022
- Registration fees are inclusive of all levies and insurance policies

Registration process

All players participating in an approved Summer Football competition must be registered to a team in the relevant competition online through the prescribed online registration system.

In addition to providing helpdesk support, FNSW issues registration guidelines to assist competitions operators and participants to navigate the online registration process.

Counting/Billing Process

Deregistration Deadline:

We have set a Deregistration Deadline of 14 days after the date the competitions are due to start or 14 days after the player's application to register (whichever is later) – if a player's deregistration is completed on or prior to the Deregistration Deadline, we will not count them in their centre's billing total. The competition start date will be as per the affiliation form submitted by the centre.

Census Date:

We will take the competition end date to be the Census Date. The competition end date will be as per the affiliation form submitted by the centre.

Counting process:

The counting process for our final player census will be as follows:

1. We will count all Registered players.
2. We will count all Deregistered players whose date of deregistration is later than the Deregistration Deadline.
3. We will count all players whose registration is Pending as at the Census Date. We will issue guidance to clubs to ensure that they either approve or decline any pending registrations to ensure that they are accurately billed.

In order to ensure that we do not bill multiple times for any one player at any given centre, we only bill the last billable registration for any player (i.e. that with the latest registration date) for each centre. If a player plays at multiple centres, they will be billed multiple times.

Registration invoices*Initial Invoice:*

Centres will be invoiced for an amount equal to 50% of active players' registration fees as at their Deregistration Deadline.

Final Invoice:

Our Final Census Date will be set at the final date of competition as per the affiliation form submitted by the centre. Following the Final Census Date, we will count all billable players and issue invoices that capture the remainder of registration fees (i.e., the billable total minus the initial invoice).
